


International Phonetic Alphabet: American English Monophthongs




Sample words:

Front Vowels	Central Vowels	Back Vowels
/i/ beet	/ə/ about (unstressed)	/u/ boot
/ı/ bit	/ə/ moth <u>er</u> (unstressed)	/ʊ/ book
/ɛ/ bet	/// but (stressed)	/o/ caught*
/æ/ bat	/³/ bird (stressed)	/a/ cot*

^{*}Some dialects of American English pronounce *caught* and *cot* with the same vowel /a/. This is called the *caught-cot merger*.

/aɪ/	bite, high
/aʊ/	bough, how
/oʊ/	boat, coat
/oɪ/	boy, toy
